- 7. Jim got a job at a ski resort. He was in charge of determining how deep the snow was. On the first day of the snow season it snowed 1 meter. The next day was warmer and .5 meter of the snow melted. On the third day it snowed 2 meters in the morning but by noon 1 meter had melted. How deep was the snow at noon?
- 8. The library started the year with 14,341 books. At the end of the first week 1456 books had been checked out. At the end of the second week 3,298 books had been checked out and 2,192 books had been returned. How many books were in the library at the end of the second week?
